Mission Statement

Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated, founded January 13, 1913, is an organization of college educated women committed to constructive development of its members and to public service with a primary focus on the Black community.

Statement of Purpose

Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. is a private, not-for-profit organization whose purpose is to provide assistance and support through established programs in local communities throughout the world. Since its founding, more than 200,000 women have joined the organization. The organization is a sisterhood of predominantly Black, college educated women. The sorority currently has 1,000 collegiate and alumnae chapters located in the United States, England, Japan (Tokyo and Okinawa), Germany, the Virgin Islands, Bermuda, the Bahamas, Jamaica and the Republic of Korea.

The major programs of the sorority are based upon the organization's Five-Point Programmatic Thrust. More than 10,000 members typically attend Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated's biennial national conventions, and each of the seven regional conferences (held during years when there is no national convention) typically hosts thousands of members.

This scholarship is sponsored by the La Marque Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. as a means of assisting deserving graduating high school students who want to continue their post-secondary education at a four-year college/university.



ELIGIBILITY:

The applicant must be an African-American graduating high school senior from a high school in the LaMarque Alumnae service area. These areas are La Marque, Texas City, Dickinson, League City, Santa Fe, and Kemah.

- The applicant must have a minimum 3.0 GPA
- The applicant must plan to attend a four-year college/university, beginning Fall 2025 or beginning Spring 2026
- The applicant must be a United States citizen

GENERAL INFORMATION:

The Scholarship Committee is comprised of members of the La Marque Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. The members of the committee will process and determine the eligibility of all scholarship applications.

All award recipients are expected to attend the Annual Scholarship Reception held late May or early June.

All submitted materials will become the property of the La Marque Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.

Scholarship awards will be processed and issued directly to the school upon proof of enrollment receipt from a four-year college or university in Fall Semester 2025 <u>or</u> Spring Semester 2026. Proof of enrollment is specified as:

An <u>official</u> enrollment verification letter from the college or university, on university letterhead, which shall include the student's name, ID number, and registered for the minimum required amount of 12 credited hours.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants <u>must</u> submit a completed application form, letters of recommendation, official transcript with the unweighted GPA included and containing the Fall 2024 semester grades, and essay to be considered for the scholarship. Eligible applicants will be evaluated based on scholastic performance, personal achievement, letters of recommendation, and personal essay. Scholarship winners will be selected from applications <u>postmarked</u> by March 14, 2025.

Official high school transcript in a sealed envelope
Two (2) letters of recommendation in sealed envelopes. The letters should detail your qualifications for the scholarship and your community service involvement. The letters should be from two different recommender types. One letter <u>must</u> be from a teacher and the second letter from another acceptable recommender. Acceptable recommenders include:
